- 1. POST : PORT FIREMAN**
- SALARY SCALE :** Rs 24,000 x 875 – 31,000 x 1,000 – 32,000x

- QUALIFICATIONS :** (i) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with Chemistry and Physics at Principal Level or passes in Chemistry and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education 'Advanced Level'
- (ii) A valid private car driving license (manual gear)
- (iii) Computer Literate
- Note:** *Selected candidates will be required to obtain a goods vehicle driving licence (manual gear) before being eligible for confirmation.*
